HIC QUEM / CRETICUS /
EDIT DEDA - / LUS EST /
LABERINT / HUS DEQ(U)- /

O NULLU - / S VADER - / E QUIVIT / QUI FUIT / INTUS / NI THESE - / US GRAT - / IS ADRIAN - / E STAMI- / NE IUTUS, meaning: Here is the Cretan labyrinth that Daedalus built. From it no one who entered could escape except Theseus, who succeeded through the grace of Ariadne's thread.
